

Chapter 3 - The Importance of Learning “Shiou Dao Fa” By Wu Ji Souls

Most of the Wu Ji souls descended on earth in this special Kur Chi (科期) period have no knowledge about their origins. They do not know where they came from and why they are here. They have to rely on their bodies to meditate in order to escape Mor Jie (末劫). They also need to study Shiu Dao Fa (修道法) and follow the right path to return to Wu Ji Heaven. If they fail to complete the study and form a chi body before the end of Kur Chi period, their souls will become Tai Ji reincarnated souls and eventually be destroyed by “Mor Jie” (末劫).

In order to help Wu Ji souls accomplish their ultimate goals, Wu Ji Academy was created by Wu-Yuan Lao Tzu (五元老祖) for the Wu Ji souls to refine their souls. It is the sacred place (聖地) where Wu Ji souls worship Wu-Yuan Lao Tzu (五元老祖) and Niang Niang (娘娘), develop full chi body through meditation and group study, and work together in the pursuit of their final destination – Wu Ji Heaven. It is also the final test site for the Wu Ji souls to be tested by Wu-Yuan Lao Tzu (五元老祖) before returning to Wu Ji Heaven.

During this Long Hwa Kur Chi (龍華科期), and also the Final Calamity Period, a time that Tai Ji reincarnated souls are allowed to take revenge for past suffering before being destroyed. Unlike the Tai Ji souls in heaven that can visit the planet earth freely to accomplish their missions, most of the Wu Ji souls today were summoned to earth by black flags or past life debtors to pay back their sins. There are many challenges and hardships created by black flags or past life debtors that need to be overcome by Wu Ji souls. These obstacles include financial difficulties, troubles from the family members, trouble with marriage, health issues, or other setbacks that would interfere with the Wu Ji souls’ study of “Shiou Dao Fa” (修道法). These obstacles are the largest challenge to Wu Ji souls in their pursuit of final goals to return to Wu Ji Heaven. It will take great determination and strong will to overcome these obstacles.

Prior to coming to earth, all Wu Ji souls were given two common missions to accomplish: Zhen Ling Guei Yuan (真靈歸原) and Fu Gu Shiu Yuan (復古修圓). Zhen Ling Guei Yuan (真靈歸原) is a mission to refine and purify the soul to its original state so it can return to its origin. Fu Gu Shiu Yuan (復古修圓) is a mission to restore traditional values so the human race can reclaim the original moral standards it had 3,000 years ago, when homes were left open at night and valuables could be easily retrieved when lost.
